- youth justice system.





The **care system** is how children who cannot live with their parents are looked after.

 looking at things written in the past 10 years about these systems.




There are 6 Easy Read documents about changes to the systems.


What tāngata whaikaha / disabled people told Oranga Tamariki



Tāngata whaikaha / disabled people told Oranga Tamariki that:



they often experience
 discrimination from services





 people cannot access services if they do not have a particular diagnosis




 disabled people are hurt more than non-disabled people



 some services that people need are not there.







- being disabled
- being Māori
- being a woman.



Having a **diagnosis** is when doctors say you have a health condition.




Tāngata whaikaha / disabled people also told Oranga Tamariki that:

 think particularly about the needs of tāngata whaikaha Māori





• getting services should be fair
